1) What is the "therefore" in Matthew 28:19 there for? Why is that significant?
2) Jesus calls us to go and make disciples – read the following passages and list the marks of a true disciple that Jesus gives us Himself: - John 4:23-24 - John 13:14-15, 34-35 - John 14:15 - John 17:16-18
3) Read Hebrews 12:1-2 What stands out to you most about the metaphor of running a race, as the writer of Hebrews describes it, and why? Is it fans (witnesses) encouraging us? Removing hindrances to run better? Needing endurance? Where our eyes are fixed while we run? Something else?
4) Who has been an encouragement and example to you as a great witness of faithfulness and endurance in following God?
Who do you think God is calling you to be this kind of example for?
5) What are some ways you can continue to be a disciple-maker even in a time of COVID?
