- 1) From 2 Corinthians 8:1-2, what are the circumstances mentioned that culminated in the Macedonian's "wealth of generosity"? Are you surprised to see any of those circumstances lead to generosity?
- 2) Paul said that the Macedonians "gave themselves first to the Lord" and then to others, resulting in their unexpected financial generosity (2 Cor. 8:4). What implications should this priority order create for us, even outside of money?
- 3) Read 1 Corinthians 16:1-4... This situation Paul coordinating the collection of money to help the church in Jerusalem is the background to what we see happening in 2 Corinthians chapters 8 and 9. What does 1 Corinthians 16:1-4 tell us about Paul's concerns/priorities?

4) In your own words how does 2 Corinthians 8:9 explain 2 Corinthians 8:8?
