- 4) In the ESV translation, 2 Corinthians 9:5 ends with the word "exaction" and the root word carries the idea of greed. After reading the passages below (which contain the same word found in 2 Corinthians 9:5) how would you describe Paul's warning/urging from 2 Corinthians 9:5 in your own words?
