2 Corinthians 11:1-15

- 1) On Sunday Pastor Tim mentioned “another Jesus” people may follow or believe in, a version of Jesus not found in Scripture. What versions or perceptions of Jesus have you heard of that go against Scripture?

- 2) Read Philippians 3:2-11... What similarities and/or differences do you see in this passage versus what we have seen in 2 Corinthians 10 and 11?

- 3) In 2 Corinthians 11:6 Paul allows the accusation to go that he is “unskilled” in his public speaking, but concerning his knowledge he does stand his ground and defends himself. Why is the one more important than the other?

Do you think Paul was being humble in allowing that accusation concerning his speech to stand?

- 4) Read 2 Timothy 2:15-19... In this passage Paul again uses the picture of a worker (“workman”) in a spiritual sense of someone supposing to work on God’s behalf. Based on Paul’s instruction to Timothy, how can we be workers approved by God as opposed to “deceitful workmen” (2 Corinthians 11:13)?

- 5) Paul uses Adam and Eve as an example of being led astray. How did Satan deceive Eve? How does that deception fit with 2 Corinthians 11:14?

In what ways do we see those kinds of deceptive tactics used today?
