- 2) From Deuteronomy 18:9-22... How can we know if someone claiming to be a prophet is legitimate?

- 3) Read the following passages and write down a job description for a prophet:
 - Exodus 7:1-2
 - 1 Kings 17:24
 - 2 Chronicles 24:18-19
 - Jeremiah 29:18-19
 - Jeremiah 35:15
 - Hebrews 1:1-2

- 4) Read Amos 1:1 and Amos 7:14-15... What do we learn about Amos and his call to prophetic ministry?

- 5) Read Amos 7:16-17... In response to accusations and threats to Amos that he should leave the king and the nation of Israel alone God delivers a strong warning of coming destruction. God desires for His people to hear from Him and repent and turn from their ungodly lifestyle and turn toward the one true God. Pray in your LifeGroups for a willingness to hear God when He speaks and repent and be changed by God's Words as well.
