Amos 5:1-17

1) Read Amos 5:1-17... What are some of God's indictments against the people of Israel through these verses in Amos?

2) Based on God's reaction in Amos 5, how would you describe the responsibility God places on His people to care for those who are needy and vulnerable?

3) Compare Amos 4:12-13 and Amos 5:14-15... How do these meetings with the "God of hosts" seem to differ?

How does Amos 5:15 give a hint of hope for those who heed the words of Amos?

4) Read Amos 5:16-17 and Exodus 12:12-13... The idea of God passing through their midst in Amos 5 is very different than our pleas today for God to be near to us. How would you summarize Amos 5:16-17?

Why does God say this scene (Amos 5:16-17) will take place if He offered a way out in the previous verses?

5) Throughout this passage the command to "seek" is repeated 4 times (5:4,5,6,14). This seeking is not passive, but is active based on Amos 5:15. How is God calling you to seek after Him and/or things that He calls good?
