Colossians 1:9-14

- 1) Colossians 1:11 mentions "...[God's] glorious might" at work in people finding strength and power. What examples have you seen of God's glorious might transforming someone's life?

- 2) In Colossians 1:11 there is a flow of strength and power (from God) that enables endurance and patience with joy in our lives. What happens if joy is not an active ingredient in this flow? Is it possible to live this way without joy?

- 3) Read Colossians 1:12-14 and make a list of all of the words used to describe the Gospel. Which of these words has the greatest impact on you? Why?

- 4) Consider this phrase: "Good works are the fruit, and not the root, of a right relationship with God." How does that phrase correlate to Colossians 1:9-14?

- 5) Read James 1:19-27 and Ephesians 2:8-10... What good works is God calling you to do, that He has prepared for you to do?
