- 1) Read Colossians 3:18 - 4:1... There are several categories of people that Paul mentions: husbands, wives, children, fathers, bondservants, and masters. What other categories do you wish Paul had included, or what categories are you surprised Paul didn't include?

Why do you think Paul only included these categories in his writing (same list in Ephesians 5:22 - 6:9)?

- 2) What theme do you see throughout Paul's instructions to these categories of people?

- 3) Read Ephesians 5:22 - 6:9... What explanation stands out to you most as Paul gives further detail about these relationships: husbands/wives, children/parents, bondservant/master?

- 4) How can Colossians 3:23-24 be carried out in a secular work environment?

What implications do you think Colossians 3:23-24 has for other areas in your life where you have responsibilities?

- 5) Last week Pastor Tim highlighted an attitude of thankfulness that permeates into everything we do (Colossians 3:15-17). How does that attitude of thankfulness relate to these commands in Colossians 3:18 - 4:1?
