

1) What do you believe are common misconceptions about Jesus?

How do you think people end up drawing those conclusions about Jesus?

2) Read John 6:1-15... After the crowd saw what Jesus did, who did they think Jesus was?

- 3) Read John 6:52-58... While the crowds were confused that Jesus might be cannibalistic, what do you think is the significance of Jesus telling us to "eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood"?
- 4) Read John 6:66-69 and consider this quote from C.S. Lewis: "We are half-hearted creatures, fooling about with drink and sex and ambition when infinite joy is offered to us." (*The Weight of Glory*)

How does C.S. Lewis' statement relate to Jesus saying He is the bread of life?

5) Read John 6:32-35 and John 6:47-51... How has your belief in Jesus changed your life? How have your hungers and thirsts changed since coming to faith in Jesus?

What would be a next step for you to lean further into finding satisfaction in Jesus alone?
