John 14:1-11

1) Read Acts 9:2; Acts 19:9, 23; Acts 22:4; and Acts 24:14, 22... Why do you think early believers grabbed onto “The Way” as a description of what they belonged to?

2) Read John 13:21-38... What would have been on the disciples’ minds to prompt Jesus to say “Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me.” (John 14:1)?

After telling His disciples to believe in Him to settle their troubled hearts, what else does Jesus say in John 14:2-7 to provide them with comfort/confidence?

3) Read John 14:8-14 and 1 John 5:10-12... What similarities do you see in these two passages?

Why do people need to believe that seeing Jesus means they have also seen God the Father?

How does the passage in 1 John 5 further explain Jesus as “the life”?

4) From Jesus’ claim in John 14:6, which of the three ways He describes Himself (the way, the truth, and the life) is the most meaningful to you?

Given these realities about Jesus (who He is and what He has done) is there anything you believe God is calling you to do in response?
