Micah 1:1-16

1) Read Micah 1:1-2. What do we learn about Micah – the person? To whom did God ask him to bring “the word of the Lord?”

2) What do we learn about the spiritual state of the leadership in the land in the timeframe of Micah’s ministry?

What did it mean to follow in the pattern of King David and King Jeroboam?

3) Read Micah 1:3-5. For what reasons is the Lord “coming out of His place” to the land of Judah & Israel?

4) Read Micah 1:6-16. What is Micah predicting will happen to the capital of the northern kingdom (Samaria) and to the towns surrounding the capital of the southern kingdom (Jerusalem)?

5) We like to think of God being full of grace and mercy toward humanity. What has caused God to bring such judgment upon Judah and Israel?
