

1) Read Micah 4:6-13. Verse 12 notes that God has a plan for both the nation of Israel ("the daughter of Zion") and for all other nations. At this juncture in your life, what plan does God have for you? How is He revealing it to you?

2) In verses 6-8, Micah continues the thoughts from vs. 1-5 about God establishing his house, mountain and word in "the latter days." Who does God assemble into His house and what are the characteristics of that assembly?

3) In verses 9-10, Micah zooms back into the "now" for the "daughter of Zion." Describe the anguish and outcome of God's action towards her. How is this rescue and redemption?

4) According to the end of verse 13, who is God and what is the impact of this position on the rest of the nations of the world? Why should this be encouraging to Israel in the midst of their pain?

5) As we have seen God's plan of judgment & hope, share a time in your life that God brought beauty (rescue/redemption) from the ashes of the impact of sin & pride in your life (Isaiah 61:3)?
